
NURSERY

Wow, Filip has been very busy making cards and his own stories! It looks like lots of fun.




RECEPTION

Tom has been practising the 'ee' sound and been on an 'ee' hunt in his house! Great learning, well done.




YEAR 1

Designing shoes has kept Year 2 busy! We are proud of Max, Nicole and Sophia for these amazing designs.




YEAR 3
