Phonics

Red words and sounds will be sent home as we teach them.

Maths

Encourage your child to spot numbers, patterns and shapes around them.

The school day starts at 8:45 am – please make sure your child arrives promptly. School finishes at 3.15pm.

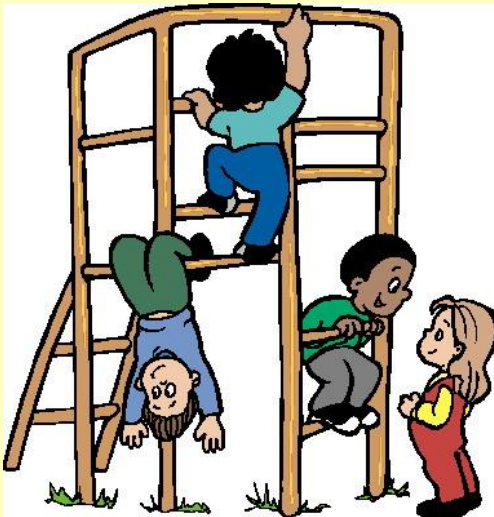
If your child is unwell, please phone the office as soon as possible to let us know. If we do not hear from you, a member of staff will phone.
